Withington Primary School Sports Premium Funding.

Plan for spending 2016/2017

From reviewing the development of PE within Withington Primary School and the subject development plans we have identified the following key areas for spending within the 2016/2017 academic year.

This year Withington Primary School will receive **£8480**

<u>Focus Area</u>	<u>Estimated Expenditure</u>
<i>Specialist delivery and leadership to oversee the PE provision.</i>	£3000 – This includes specialist teaching from ABEC staff to KS2 and KS1 pupils. £2000 – PE leadership
<i>CPD opportunities for other staff.</i>	£500 – This is also dependent on the opportunities available. Courses for the day range from £30-£60 +cover and travel expenses for the staff.
<i>Sporting opportunities for identified groups.</i>	£ 700 - With Ride2Acheive 6 pupils throughout the school identified for development (Personal, social, SEN or EAL) would go on a 6 week riding block.
<i>Change4lifecub.</i>	£ 80 - Delivery course already budgeted in last years CPD opportunities. Personalised t-shirts for club leaders (10 in varying sizes)
<i>Specialist PE sessions</i>	£700 – Outside agencies to come in and teach 6x 2 hour sessions (1 hour for KS1, 1 hour for KS2) a specialist PE opportunity that staff cannot provide (Fencing, Street dance <u>or</u> martial arts). This will help to provide children with a wider access to different physical opportunities. This is an estimated budget depending on quotes from agencies.
<i>Equipment to support the delivery of the new curriculum.</i>	£1000 budget to provide new equipment throughout the entire PE curriculum offered at Withington.

<i>Continue understanding of healthy eating.</i>	£500 - Healthy lessons within classrooms teaching the children the benefits of healthy options and showing children how to prepare a healthy meal from scratch.
<i>Total Estimated Expenditure</i>	£8480
